

# MUELLER FAMILY MS & T STEM SCHOLARSHIP

A scholarship fund with the Ste. Genevieve County Community Foundation  
CRITERIA

administered by  COMMUNITY FOUNDATION of the OZARKS

**Purpose:** To support a graduating senior from Ste. Genevieve Public High School or Valle High School who has been accepted by the Missouri University of Science & Technology with the intent of pursuing Science Technology, Engineering or Mathematics, a STEM related field of study.

**Amount:** The scholarship is dependent upon amount available to spend (ATS).

One \$500.00 scholarship will be awarded for the 2017-18 academic year.

**Eligibility:**

1. Graduating Senior from Ste. Genevieve Public High School or Valle High School who has been accepted by the Missouri University of Science & Technology with the intent of pursuing a STEM related field of study.
2. Demonstrate financial need; submit FAFSA-EFC form
3. Participation in school and community activities
4. Demonstrate leadership activities
5. Work History
6. GPA/SAT or ACT; submit transcript

**Selection Committee:** The Selection Committee will be composed of the Ste. Genevieve County Community Foundation Board. [Should the successful applicant not attend MS & T as required, the Ste. Genevieve County Community Foundation may award the scholarship to another applicant].

The Selection Committee will be responsible for providing CFO's scholarship coordinator with the name of the recipient and application. If the Committee is not maintaining a file on all applications, all applications will be sent to CFO.

Children of the Selection Committee are not eligible for the scholarship unless that committee member resigns from the committee.

Criteria may be amended upon the recommendation of the selection committee with the approval of the Donor and the Board of Directors of the Community Foundation of the Ozarks.

**Selection Calendar and Process:** Scholarship applications will be available from the counselor's office and should be returned to that office. The CFO deadline for receiving the selected recipient(s) name/copy of Apps to CFO is printed on the App and posted on website.

**Notification of Recipient:** The recipient will receive an award letter from CFO with the instructions to go to the CFO website [www.cfozarks.org](http://www.cfozarks.org) and *activate* their scholarship for payment.

**Distribution of Funds:** When required documentation is received, payment will be made to the recipient's college account. If the recipient withdraws from school, the unused funds will be returned to CFO for deposit in the scholarship fund.
