What is Impact 100?

Impact 100 Dent County is a charitable funding program designed to improve the quality of life in the Dent County area. One hundred (or more) women will be recruited to donate \$250 annually. Then, every year those same 100 women (or more) will meet to hear presentations from local non-profit organizations and vote to award grants.



Promoting philanthropy among women with an innovative pass-through foundation was the idea of Wendy Steele which created IMPACT 100. Impact 100 can bring grants to the communities it serves across five focus areas: Arts/Culture/Tourism, Education, Community Betterment/Environment/Preservation, Family and Health & Wellness.
